AI TRAINING

AI TRAINING SESSION CONDUCTED FOR JOURNALISTS AND STUDENTS



On November 17, 2025, Mr. Sudhakar Reddy Udumula, Editor- Investigations at Times of India, conducted an AI training session for journalists and students under the ADiRA initiative (AI for Digital Readiness and Advancement) at Block-7, Computer Lab.

During the session, he discussed how to detect AI-generated videos and deepfakes, as well as the various tools and websites available for checking AI-generated content, including text, photos, videos, and audio. He emphasised the importance of learning AI tools, highlighting that in today's world, AI and humans collectively form the workforce.

Mr. Sudhakar Reddy addressed how careers are evolving due to the introduction of AI and what we can expect in the near future. He explained the fundamentals of how AI works and introduced the best tools for various tasks. Additionally, he pointed out the potential pitfalls of AI and stressed the need to verify any content generated through these technologies.

Mr. Sudhakar Reddy also explored how AI can be utilised in newsrooms, discussing its limitations and the precautions necessary when using AI tools. Using a PowerPoint presentation and live demonstrations, he illustrated how various AI tools can be leveraged to make a journalist's work more efficient.

He concluded the session by stressing our ethical responsibilities when using AI. The training was interactive and hands-on, allowing participants to gain a deeper understanding of AI and encouraging them to continue enhancing their knowledge and applying it responsibly.
