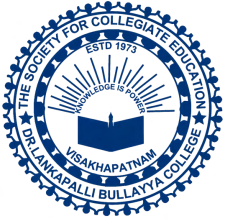

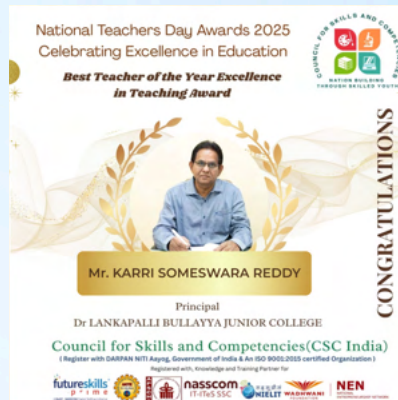
EISC LAUNCHES BOOK FOR ED COURSE CONTENT
