The Women's Engineering College served the cause of women empowerment and development by providing meritorious service for a decade. The Women's Engineering College then evolved into a full-fledged Co-education Engineering college in the academic year 2020-2021. The college is offering B.Tech Program in four branches of Engineering including CSE, ECE, EEE and Civil with an annual intake of 120 each for CSE and ECE while the intake for EEE and Civil being 60 seats. The college is approved by AICTE, New Delhi and Permanently Affiliated to Andhra University, Visakhapatnam.




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Organization Structure


